

OFFICIAL GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT

NOVEMBER 7, 2000

1. To vote for a person whose name is printed on the ballot, fill in the oval in the first-choice column to the right of the name of the person.
2. For State and Federal offices you may also indicate a second or third choice, in case your first-choice candidate is eliminated in a runoff, by filling in a circle in the second or third-choice column to the right of the first-choice oval.
3. Marking a second or third choice cannot help defeat your first-choice candidate.
4. To vote for a person not listed on the ballot, write the candidate's name on the line provided AND fill in the appropriate oval or circle.

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER











- A. To vote, complete the arrow(s)   pointing to your first choice(s), like this  
- B. You may also indicate your alternate choice candidates, in case you first choice is eliminated in a runoff, by connecting the arrow in line with the 2nd choice, 3rd choice, or other ranking in the section of the ballot marked off for those alternate candidates. Marking a second, third, or subsequent choice cannot help defeat your first choice candidate.
- C. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the candidate's name on the line provided AND complete the arrow.
- D. If you wrongly mark, tear or deface the ballot, return it to an election official and obtain another.

SAMPLE GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT

To vote for a person whose name is printed on the ballot, mark a cross (X) in the square to the right of that person's name and party designation. For state and federal offices you may also indicate one second-choice and one third-choice candidate, in case your first choice is eliminated in a runoff, by marking the second or third choice circle in line with those candidates' names. Marking a second or third choice cannot help defeat your first choice candidate.

To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the person's name on the blank line in the appropriate block.
