We believe the coming years offer great opportunities to advance FairVote's reform vision. The time is right for us to redouble our efforts. FairVote works collaboratively with groups and individuals from across the spectrum, but is uncompromising in our pursuit of a more representative democracy. Our vision of fair access to participation, fair elections and fair representation is grounded in respect for every vote and every voice. Our future depends on all Americans harnessing our democracy's potential to address today's pressing challenges.

Changes in America's elections are overdue. Historically, major reforms in elections and voting rights have come in half-century waves – after the Civil War, at the time of World War I and in the 1960s. We seek to trigger and guide a new wave of democratic expansion. The arc of history may bend towards democracy, but it needs a nudge from FairVote – and all of us.
