

# Instant runoff voting: A primer

Burlington voters have an opportunity to rank their preferences for mayor on their ballots in this year's mayoral election. How it works:

## For MAYOR

Three-Year Term

*Special instructions: Rank candidates for mayor in order of choice.*

- Fill in the number 1 oval (1) to the right of your 1st choice candidate.
- You may rank as many or as few candidates as you wish.
- Fill in the number 2 oval (2) to the right of your 2nd choice candidate.
- Fill in the number 3 oval (3) to the right of your 3rd choice, and so on.
- Fill in no more than one oval per column.
- Fill in no more than one oval per candidate.

## HOW YOU VOTE

Mark the oval in the "1st choice" column next to your first choice for mayor. If you choose, you may fill in ovals for second choice, third choice, etc. You do not have to make more than one choice.

	1st choice	2nd choice	3rd choice	4th choice
<b>John</b>	1	2	3	4
<b>Paul</b>	1	2	3	4

## HOW A RUNOFF WORKS

If no candidate is the first choice of 50 percent of the voters, an instant runoff ensues. If your first choice is the lowest vote-getter, your ballot counts for your second choice. If your second choice is later eliminated, your ballot counts for your third choice, and so on.

**John 48%**  
**Paul 41%**  
**George 7%**  
**Ringo 4%**

The ballots that had Ringo as their first choice are retabulated. The second choices from those ballots are added to the remaining candidates' totals.

**John 51%**  
**Paul 42%**  
**George 7%**  
**John wins!**

### ■ WHEN THE RUNOFF ENDS

As soon as one candidate receives 50 percent.
